### **Local EOC Operator:**

- Maintain ICS214A log throughout exercise
- Activate local net with control operator
- Designate local operator to monitor for exercise traffic on 3.955Mhz
- Send a single IC213 General Message to all participating EOC's. (List to be provided)
- Reply to at least one neighbor EOC using their received ICS213.
- Submit log ICS214A log to K7UNI

# **Local Net Control Operator:**

- Maintain ICS309 log throughout the exercise
- Assign each check-in a facility ID
- Log current weather information from operators periodically
- Submit ICS309 log to K7UNI

# **Local Operators:**

- Check-in to the local net
- Log your assigned facility number
- Maintain a log for any traffic you exchange. (ICS-309 works great for this)
- Report current weather and counts for your facility ID as requested
- Submit log to K7UNI

## **EOC to EOC Voice Traffic:**

- Exchange current weather and roll counts for your County
- Avoid making any resource requests using voice.

#### Simulated Voice Traffic:

• Any **simulated voice traffic** should begin and end with a statement of exercise. Sample:

K7UNI this is AL1Q, I have a message for you, prepare to copy.

AL1Q this is K7UNI, send your traffic.
